The introduction of the new testing codes in 2019 has resulted in a major paradigm shift in how developmental, psychological and neuropsychological testing services are documented and billed. Indeed, practitioners, coders and compliance officers have all previously struggled with identifying how to apply testing codes when work is performed by the professional and technician together, how to bill across multiple days, how to bill for feedback sessions and how to bill for non-face to face work (i.e., integration) by the professional. With the advent of these new codes comes new considerations in how to bill and document our services, both professional and technical. This presentation will review the new testing code structure and what we have learned since its implementation in terms of changes to professional practice and documentation requirements. "What's next" regarding CPT® codes and psychological testing practice will also be discussed.

Dr. Pliskin is past President of the Society for Clinical Neuropsychology of the American Psychological Association and has served as APA advisor to the AMA/CPT Health Care Professionals Advisory Committee since 2009.
